

TRiO Trip Travel Guidelines

Please review the following guidelines with the TRiO participant before departure so they know what is expected of them on the trip. Failure to follow the guidelines by any student may result in ineligibility to travel with TRiO Pre-College Programs in the future.

- ⌘ Treat fellow students & staff with courtesy and respect at all times.
- ⌘ No alcohol, illicit drugs, tobacco or conscience-altering substances may be possessed/used by students.
- ⌘ Students are expected to behave as young adults and be respectful when traveling and visiting campuses. We will be on campuses and do not want to disturb students who may be studying or in class. (No screaming, running, horseplay or PDA)
- ⌘ **TRiO Buddy System** – In specific public places students may be allowed to pair up with a fellow TRiO student without direct staff supervision for an allotted amount of time. Students will be notified of times they are allowed to use the “buddy-system” and they **MUST** have a buddy!
- ⌘ Everyone is responsible for his or her own valuables.
- ⌘ Participants must stay in their rooms after bed check and are not allowed in rooms of the opposite gender under any circumstances.
- ⌘ Students must dress appropriately at all times; please see TRiO dress code below.

DRESS CODE

Students and staff are expected to have an appropriate, well-groomed appearance while participating in TRiO activities. Remember to dress appropriately for the season as weather can change dramatically.

TOPS

Appropriate tops are to be worn at all times. Tops must cover cleavage and torso; undergarments are not to be exposed.

BOTTOMS

All bottoms must be thumb-length or longer. No sagging or hanging bottoms, undergarments are not to be exposed.

SHOES

Shoes must be worn at all times, including inside the hotel. Students will be doing a lot of walking so comfortable shoes are encouraged.

OTHER

Clothing, patches, buttons, pins, tattoos or jewelry with sexually suggestive writing/pictures, advocating violence, or promoting the use of tobacco, alcohol or drugs are not permitted.
